



(A) the principles of financial membership,

- (1) Any person who supports the objects or purposes of the station is *eligible* to apply for membership via appropriate membership forms in order to become a member.
- (2) There will be a process of interview(s) with the eligible person prior to acceptance of the membership.
- (3) An individual who has not reached the age of 16 years is not eligible to apply for a class of membership that confers full voting rights and will need to be accompanied by an adult member, with appropriate and up to date children protection certificates (CPP).
- (4) The application must be signed by the applicant and the member nominating the applicant.
- (5) The management committee must consider each application for membership of the station and decide whether to accept or reject the application.
- (6) The committee may consider applications in the order in which they are received by the station.
- (7) The committee could postpone the final decision for an application should there be any issues in relation to the application that may need clarification by the applicant or more information would be needed from the applicant.
- (8) The management committee may or may not accept an applicant, at their discretion and notify the applicant in writing as soon as practicable after the interview.
- (9) The applicant is encouraged to apply for Child Protection certificate prior to starting their duties.
- (10) The member must pay the required membership fees within one week of receiving an invoice for the membership fees, either in writing or via email.

Membership cessation

- (1) A person ceases to be a member due to any of the following reasons
 - (a) the member dies;
 - (b) the person resigns from the station;
 - (c) the person is expelled from the station;
- (2) The secretary must update the member's records, within a month that a member ceases membership due to above reasons, specifying the date and the reason that the membership ceases.
